



Swissvale Farmers Market Covid-19 Customer Guidelines

The Allegheny County *Stay at Home* order lists farmers markets as essential businesses. The Swissvale Farmers Market will be opening as scheduled on June 6, 2020. To ensure the safety of our vendors, customers, and staff we will be operating under guidance provided by the PA Department of Agriculture and will be adhering to best practices as outlined by the Center for Disease Control. This will entail considerable changes to our operating procedures but the safety of our community is our prime consideration. We look forward to seeing you at our community market this summer and know that you will work with us in following these guidelines and keeping all of our family of vendors, volunteers, and customers safe and healthy. As we are working through ever changing times these rules will be updated as often as necessary. Watch for updates on our website and our facebook page.

- All customers must wear masks.
 - No dogs other than service dogs will be permitted at the market.
 - We encourage only 1 person per household attend the market at a time to minimize congestion.
 - To ensure social distancing we will be limiting the number of customers at the market at any given time. Please wait patiently if a line occurs while waiting to enter the market.
 - Please enter and exit the market at designated points only.
 - Please adhere to 6 feet social distancing while at the market.
 - Please observe all posted signage.
 - We are designating the time from 9:00 am to 9:45 am for our high-risk customers (seniors and those with underlying health issues). We ask that our other customers respect this guidance.

- Please do not ask vendors to pack your reusable shopping bags. Allow them to place your purchases on a table and step back before you pack your bag yourself.
- Do not touch any product that you are not buying.
- Customers are asked to not linger or congregate at the market. There will be no music and all prepared foods will be packaged for takeout only.
- If you are sick or anyone in your household is showing signs of being sick please stay home.
